


# The Amish Anomaly: A Control Group Study



The Amish population serves as a critical 'control group' for modern health outcomes. With a vaccination rate near zero, their chronic disease profile is drastically different from the general US population.

## Key Findings:

- Asthma rates are ~4x lower than the general population.
- Allergy sensitization is ~6x lower.
- Autism prevalence is estimated at 1 in 10,000, compared to 1 in 36 in the US.

This data challenges the assumption that chronic illness is an inevitable part of modern life.
